WELCOME TO VIENNA

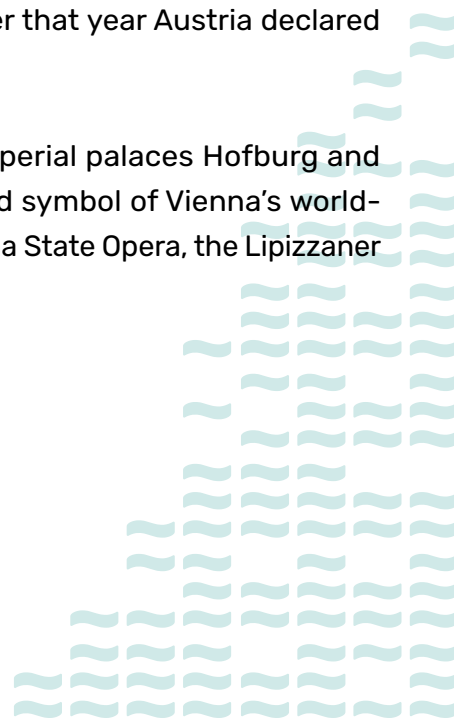
The Austrian Swimming Federation has the honor and pleasure to invite you to the European Junior Open Water Swimming Championships 2024 to be held at the New Danube. The venue is located in the famous city of Vienna.

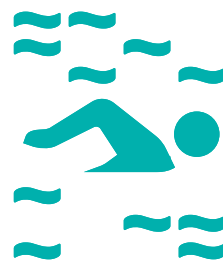


Vienna is the capital, largest city, and one of nine federal states of Austria. Vienna is Austria's most populous city with about two million inhabitants and represents the cultural, economic and political center of Austria. Vienna is host to many major international organizations, including the United Nations, OPEC and the OSCE. In 2001 the city center was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Evidence has been found of continuous habitation in the Vienna area since 500 BC. In 15 BC, the Romans fortified the frontier city they called Vindobona. In 1804, during the Napoleonic Wars, Vienna became the capital of the newly formed Austrian Empire. The city continued to play a major role in European and world politics. After World-War II Vienna was divided into sectors by the four powers: the US, the UK, France, and the Soviet Union. The four-power control of Vienna lasted until the Austrian State Treaty was signed in May 1955, later that year Austria declared it's everlasting neutrality.

Major tourist attractions include St. Stephen's Cathedral, the imperial palaces Hofburg and Schönbrunn and the Giant Ferris Wheel, trademark of the city and symbol of Vienna's world-famous Prater. Cultural highlights include the Burgtheater, the Vienna State Opera, the Lipizzaner horses at the Spanish Riding School and the Vienna Boys' Choir.

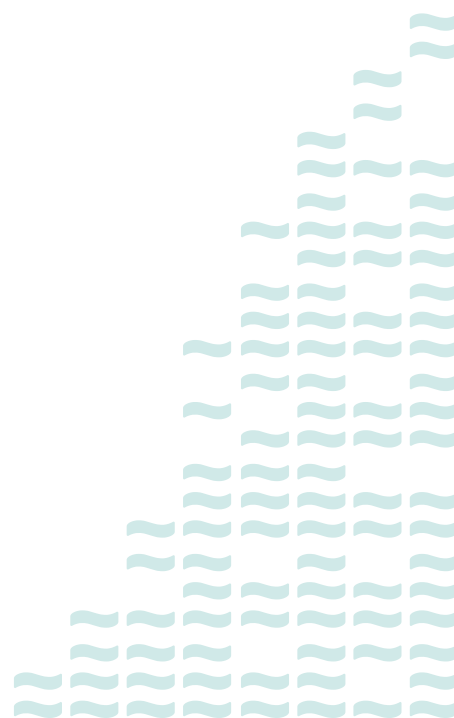


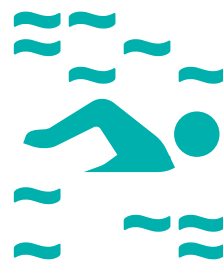

COMPETITION VENUE

All the events will be held at the Rowing Center New Danube in Vienna. The Rowing Center is located in the 22nd district and about 7 km away from the city center of Vienna. The two-kilometer regatta course was built in 1990 as a training and competition venue. It was also the venue for the 1991 World Rowing Championships.

An expansion in 2019 has added around 600 square meters with new boat halls and training infrastructure, such as new strength and ergometer rooms.

The river channel has a width of around 160 meters. Along the channel are pathways and roads suitable for bicycles or roller skates. There are spaces for participants, toilets, showers and a stand for approximately 500 spectators.

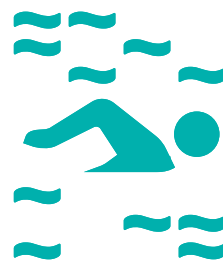

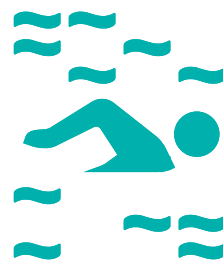

TRAINING VENUE

Training will be arranged in the 50 meters swimming pool at the Stadionbad (Meiereistraße 7, 1020 Vienna). Each nation will receive a certain number of access wristbands at the welcome desk in the hotel. A deposit of €50 per person will be charged when the access wristbands are issued. This amount can be paid either in cash (EURO) or by bank transfer (proof of payment). If the access wristbands are returned in full on the day of departure, the amount will be refunded in the same way as received.

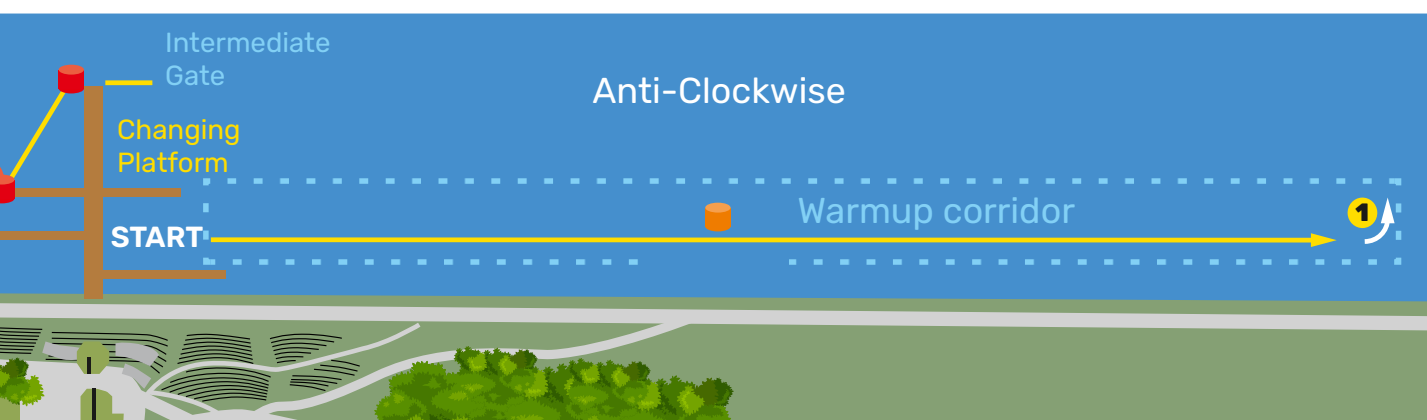
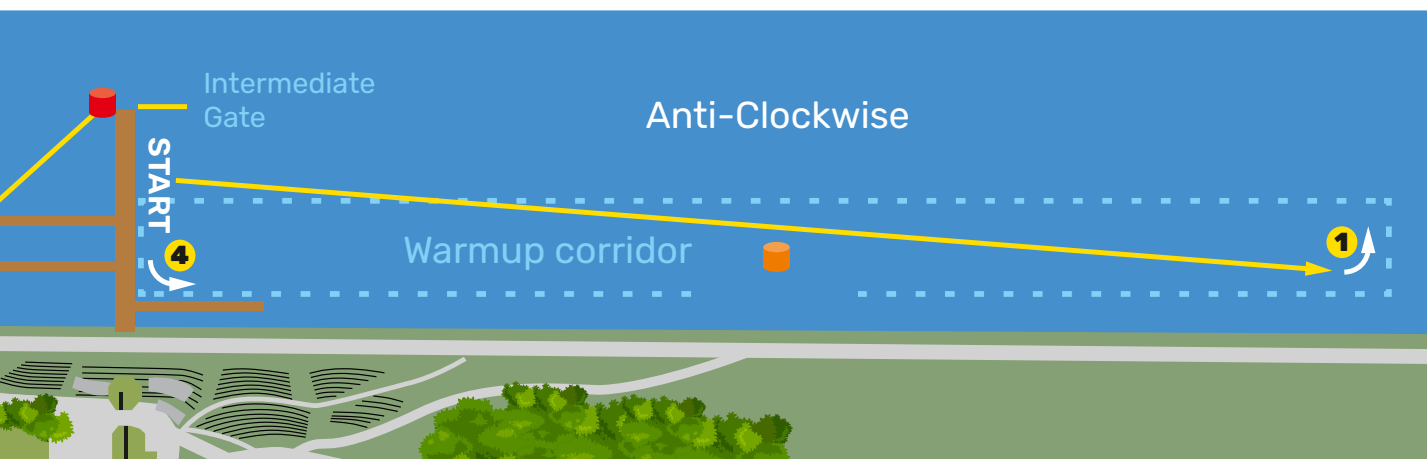




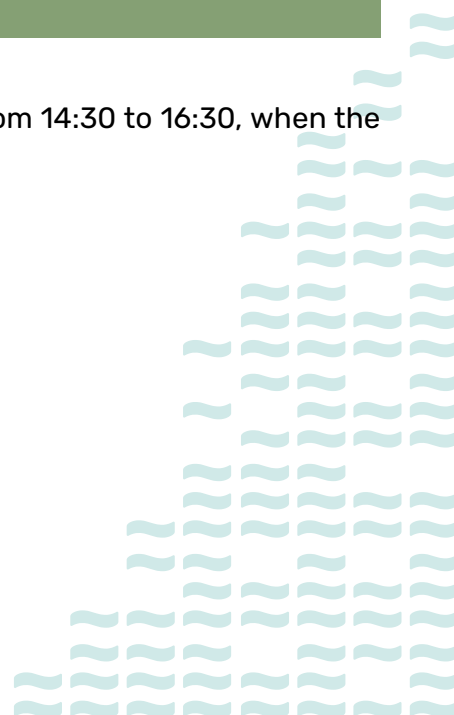
TRAINING COMPETITION VENUE

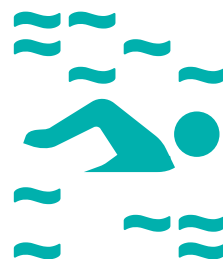
For trainings at the competition venue there will be a specific area (Warmup corridor) where the athletes can swim.

IMPORTANT FEEDING INFORMATION

In the interest of preserving the environment, and according to the decision taken by the European Aquatics Bureau in Malta (MLT) in March 2018 on the occasion of the European Aquatics Bureau Meeting, the use of **biodegradable cups** will be compulsory. Any other container (plastic bottles or cups) will be strictly forbidden on the feeding pontoon. The Organizer will provide all participants with authorized cups.

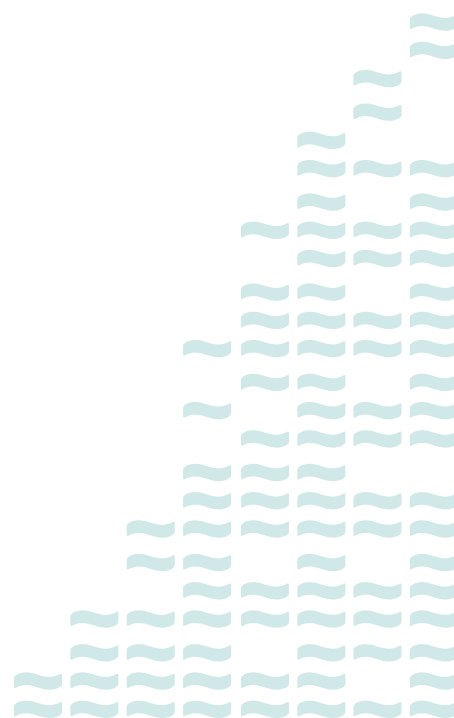
TRANSPORTATION

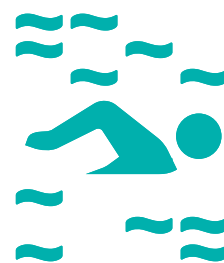
Transport by bus will be provided only for participating teams that have ordered the accommodation through the Austrian Swimming Federation.
